Amidst the beautiful and unspoilt Ettrick Valley a place of rolling hills winding rivers and pine forests this lovingly restored farmhouse parts of which date from the 14th century is the perfect setting for a relaxing break. A 15 mile drive leads to sailing and fishing on St Mary's Loch – the largest natural loch in the Borders – and beside it lies Maggets reservoir where Hartwoodmyres visitors can enjoy free fishing. Historic towns battle sites and castles abound and Edinburgh's fine architecture great shopping and wealth of cultural delights are only 40 miles away. Horse riding and golf are available nearby.
