Surrounded by 25 acres of grounds in the heart of the South Downs National Park these delightful properties offer a tranquil retreat within easy reach of a wonderful range of outdoor pursuits and places of cultural interest. Enjoying free access to a stretch of river with fishing rights and shared use of a summer house they sit near the owners' home on a country estate in Stedham a tiny village just 2 miles from Midhurst. Livery for visitors' own horses is available (at extra cost) and the grounds are also home to donkeys which may be ridden on request and retired polo ponies. Cowdray Park for golf and polo horse racing at Fontwell and Goodward Singleton's open air museum Petworth House and other National Trust properties are all nearby. Haslemere is under 10 minutes' drive and Chichester Petersfield and Billingshurst are a little further afield. Pub serving food ½ mile shops 2 miles.
